The Choir of Royal Holloway is considered to be one of the finest mixed-voice university choirs in the UK. The 24 choral scholars that constitute the College's Chapel Choir undertake a busy schedule of services, concerts and tours and recordings. Benefits include:

- A Scholarship of £700 for choral scholars, and £1500 for organ scholars per annum.
- An active recording schedule (Three releases in 2020, and three recording projects).
- Regular concert appearances (around 60 per annum), with a weekly lunchtime concert which is live-streamed.
- At least one tour per year, as well as Festival appearances around the UK.
- Regular broadcasts on BBC Radios 3 & 4.
- Opportunities to work with other ensembles, such as the Britten Sinfonia, Fretwork, and the London Mozart Players.
- Living in the beautiful campus, west of London.
- A highly-respected academic institution (a top 20 UK university 2020, with a Music Department regularly placed in the top-10), with average offers of AAB-ABB, with exciting prospects for graduates.
- A hugely diverse repertoire, and a focus on one-per-part ensemble singing.
